Location and dates of the session:, in COMBLOUX (74) (site modifiable according to snow conditions).

1. Target audience: All people in good physical and athletic condition as well as a sense of responsibility allowing them to assess the risks for the passenger in their care who is over 16 years old. For minors or persons with disabilities, please contact us.

2. Prerequisites: open to those with a good level of skiing at least equivalent to class 3 of the French Ski course (advanced descent in turns, wedeling and direct lines, on all snow and on all types of slopes), if possible, already having practical experience.

3. Educational objectives:

Assist and safely accompany sit-skiers on the terrain

- ◆ Master the equipment, the concepts of adjustments, maintenance, upkeep and the installation of the seated skier
- ◆ Master general information on ski lifts and use of chairlifts
- ◆ Drive a Tetraski and take the ski lifts
- ◆ Have knowledge of regulations and vertical evacuation

4. Educational process and duration: 28 hours in 4 days

The organization of the pedagogical schedule can vary depending on the weather conditions.

5. Rate: 650 € for teaching costs per participant for the session (excluding accommodation/meals and other personal expenses). Lift passes are not included. We offer a 100€ option for the lift pass, to be confirmed at the time of registration. If you do not take this option, you must be in possession of your lift pass before the start of the course. (please bring any business cards you may need).

6. Participants: 6 trainees pour 1 instructor.

7. Details: Face-to-face at the training location indicated in paragraph 1.

Complete and return the registration form by e-mail, or by post with all the required documents. The trainee will receive an invitation by e-mail indicating the exact time and place of the meeting. The association reserves the right to cancel the session if conditions so require (e.g. insufficient snow conditions, insufficient number of candidates). The day is devoted to practice on the snow, with theoretical aspects dealt with at the end of the day.

8. Equipment required: All specific equipment is provided free of charge, as is the manufacturer's manual. All skiers must bring their own personal equipment (warm clothing, helmet, gloves, etc.) as well as ski boots and skis measuring between 140 and 150cm if possible (we can lend you skis on request).

9. Monitoring and evaluation procedures: Evaluation and feedback by the trainer throughout and at the end of the course.

10. Course completion: Issuance of a training certificate and a certificate of completion. If the trainee has the required level to operate the machine independently, he or she will be issued with an accreditation card by the machine manufacturer.

11. Teaching method: Tétraski training on the slopes with an instructor
Study of the medical aspects of disability in practice and the machine manufacturer's manual

12. Registration deadlines: return of the complete registration form 2 weeks before the start of the course. Please contact us if you are unable to do so.

Ability to accompany and pilot a Tetraski with a disabled person as passenger, on the slopes and at the lifts, without any teaching prerogatives.
